Happy Halloween! October is a time of winding down from the summer months, and it is a great time to attend to some crime prevention measures around the home. Utilize the milder weather to trim trees and bushes that might provide cover for criminal activity. Add more light around your home, and replace any bulbs that have stopped working. Clean up your yard and property. It is also a great time to install that exterior security camera you have been thinking about. Check door locking mechanisms to make sure they are in good working order, and check all of your windows to make sure they are secure. Halloween may be a time for ghosts and goblins, but the real threat is the one from thieves looking for an opportunity. Let's make it harder for them.

### **Scammers and Scoundrels**

Yet another Facebook scam to report. You may have gotten a message on Facebook recently from a friend saying that they've gotten another friend request from you. The message then advises you to forward a warning. It's a scam!

Any message that you receive asking you to cut and paste the content and then forward it to all your friends is usually a scam. The message making its rounds once again says that your account has been cloned or hacked, and that you should forward the warning to all your friends. Don't fall for it. It's likely that the message itself it is a scam, and you will make your account vulnerable. If you receive a message like this, first search your name to see if there is a cloned account out there. If there is, report it immediately to Facebook.



- Go to the menu, and select Settings. Choose Security and then Where You're Logged In.
- You will see a list of all of the devices that you've logged into and their locations. If you see anything that isn't you, click Log Out on the right side of the log to end the session. The hacker will be logged out temporarily.
- Then be sure to change your password. It's a good practice to occasionally change your passwords on a regular basis.
