**ORDINANCE NO. 1292, SERIES 2013**

**AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO AMENDMENT OF THE JEFFERSONTOWN,  
KENTUCKY CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 111: ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES**

**WHEREAS**, Kentucky General Assembly has enacted Senate Bill 13, amending KRS 242, et seq, and KRS 243.070; and,

**WHEREAS**, the amendments to KRS 242, et seq, and KRS 243.070 require the City of Jeffersontown, Kentucky to amend its existing Ordinances relating to Alcoholic Beverages; and,

**WHEREAS**, new application forms are required for applicants prior to June 25, 2013.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the City Council of Jeffersontown, Kentucky that said City Council does hereby amend Chapter 111 of its codified City Ordinances as follows:

Section I: Chapter 111.01: **HOURS OF SALE**

(A)(1) Distilled Spirits and Wine. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation, licensed for the sale of distilled spirits or wine at retail, to sell, give away, permit to be sold or given away, or permit on the licensed premises to consumption of the products between the hours of 4:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. on any weekday and Saturday, or between the hours of 4:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. Sunday, ~~or on Election Day when polls are open in Jefferson County, Kentucky.~~

(A)(2) Malt Beverages. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation, licensed for the sale of malt beverages at retail, to sell, give away, permit to be sold or given away, or permit on the licensed premises the consumption of the products between the hours of 4:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. on any weekday and Saturday, or between the hours of 4:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. Sunday, ~~or on any Election Day when the polls are open in Jefferson County, Kentucky.~~

Section II: Chapter 111.16 **LICENSE FEES**, of the City of Jeffersontown, Kentucky codified Ordinances is hereby amended as follows:

- (E) ~~Retail distilled spirits package license, per annum - \$1,200.00;~~  
Quota Retail Package License, per annum - \$1,200.00
  
- (F) ~~Retail distilled spirits drink license, per annum - \$1,600.00;~~  
Quota Distilled Spirits Drink License, per annum - \$1,600.00
  
- (G)(2) Any person, firm or corporation not holding a license to sell distilled spirits at retail within the corporate boundaries of Jeffersontown, Kentucky - ~~\$600.00~~

- (H) ~~Special private club distilled spirits, per annum - \$75.00;~~  
N Q-3 Retail Drink License (private clubs) \$75.00
  
- (K) ~~Malt beverage retailer's license:~~  
(1) N Q-4 (Retail Malt Beverage Drink License)
  - (1) New applicant - \$200.00;
  - (2) Renewals - \$150.00; and,
  - (3) Special temporary license, per month or part of month - \$12.50(2) N Q Retail Malt Beverage Package License
  - (1) New applicant - \$200.00;
  - (2) Renewals - \$150.00; and,
  - (3) Special temporary license, per month or part of month - \$12.50
  
- (L) ~~Restaurant wine license (subject to the provisions of KRS 243.032):~~  
N Q-2 Retail drink license (restaurant drink license, motel drink license, restaurant wine license, subject to provisions of KRS 243.032
  - (1) Original issue, per annum - \$600.00; and,
  - (2) Annual renewal - \$400.00
  
- (M) ~~Convention center - \$2,000.00; and~~  
N Q-1: Retail drink license (convention centers) - \$2,000.00

Section III: Any Ordinance or parts of Ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance are repealed in so far as same affect this Ordinance.

Section IV: This Ordinance shall take affect and be enforced on June 25, 2013, following passage and publication.
