BLOCK WATCH NEWSLETTER -FEBRUARY 2015

Do you or your spouse come home after dark? Do you have problems with criminal mischief to your property during the night? Do you feel as secure as you would like after dark? Lighting is one of the biggest deterrents to criminal activity. Each home is unique in design and will require different positioning of lighting fixtures. You can consult with your electrician or the Crime Prevention Unit of the Jeffersontown Police Department, (Jeffersontown residents only), for help with your particular needs. Consider the addition of exterior lighting to your home. Some things to think about if you do install additional lighting, is to use a photoelectric cell with each fixture. This photoelectric cell turns the light on at dusk and off at dawn. This will eliminate the need to reset timers and remember to turn them on/off. If the lighting is installed in your back yard and you entertain and don't want all of this lighting on at the same time, consider installing a separate switch, which would allow you to temporarily turn these lights off. (Otherwise the switch stays on all the time.) These photoelectric cells can be installed to existing lighting also. When choosing types of lighting remember it doesn't need to be so bright that you can read a newspaper, just enough to take away the shadows. Visit your local home improvement stores for examples of what is available.
