The warm weather has once again arrived. The annual pilgrimage to the outdoors has begun. This month I would like to address some things to consider when working in your yard, having a yard sale, etc.

When you are outside in your yard, make sure you lock the doors to your home even though you may be able to see them. When people become engrossed with what they are doing, they tend to tune out everything around them. This allows someone to enter the residence unnoticed. Have an extra key to your door made. You can put it in your pocket, tie it to your shoelace, (this also works well for runners and walkers that do not have pockets) or whatever works for you. Be aware of what is going on around you. If you hear a dog bark, a vehicle door close, the smell of a cigarette/cigar, cologne/perfume, etc., take the time to look around.

Take a portable phone or cell phone outside with you. Be prepared for a medical emergency, as well as suspicious activity. Expect the unexpected. Whether you're working in the yard, having a yard sale, or just going to the store for a "minute", close the garage door so that you are not "advertising" items that could be an easy target for theft.

These are a few things you can do to lessen your chances of becoming a victim.
