**AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING KENNETH WRIGHT
HATMAKER AS CHIEF OF THE JEFFERSONTOWN
POLICE DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS, there is a vacancy in the Office of Chief of the Jeffersontown Police Department, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has appointed **Kenneth Wright Hatmaker** to become the Chief of the Jeffersontown Police Chief, subject to the approval of the Jeffersontown City Council.

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF
JEFFERSONTOWN, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Due to the concerns for public safety and the pressing need to have a Chief of the Jeffersontown Police Department in order to best serve the public interests of health, safety and welfare, it is declared that an emergency exists, and by a two-thirds vote of the City Council, the need for a second reading of this Ordinance is hereby waived.

Section 2. **Kenneth Wright Hatmaker** is hereby appointed as the Chief of the Jeffersontown Police Department and for purposes of compensation shall be considered a G14 employee.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon being signed by the Mayor.
