As you know, many areas of our community have seen increasing numbers of burglaries, vehicle break-ins and a lot of criminal mischief. While our department is working hard to catch all those involved in this activity, (we have had some success in several areas) we always need your help. This is the time that the Block Watch members need to use their extra eyes and ears to alert the police department of any suspicious activity. If you take walks in your neighborhood, whether it is morning, afternoon or evening take along a cell phone. The cell phone allows you to contact the police department immediately if there is a problem. These problems could be a person following you, disorderly people damaging property, reckless drivers or even a medical emergency.

Be alert to suspicious vehicles in the area. They may be scouting the area for easy thefts. Make sure your vehicles are locked at all times. If you hear a dog barking, don't ignore this potential alarm. The dog may be barking at something. Someone may be in your garage, shed or vehicle. Take a moment and look out the window.

If you are having a yard sale, put your sale items away from the garage and backyard. Keep your garage door closed. Some people that come to yard sales sometimes shop to see what you have in your backyard or garage. Then they return later to steal these items. Do not let anyone into your house to use the restroom. Sometimes a person will use the excuse that a small child needs to use the restroom. Once inside, anything can happen. Whether working in the garden, having a yard sale, mowing the lawn or playing in the yard with your kids, LOCK THE DOOR! It only takes a second for someone to slip into your house.
