**ORDINANCE NO. 1354, SERIES 2016**

**AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE AMENDMENT OF ORDINANCE NO. 1277, SERIES 2012, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE 1283, SERIES 2012, ORDINANCE 1310, SERIES 2014, ORDINANCE 1336, SERIES 2016, AND ORDINANCE 1339, SERIES 2016, RELATING TO COMPENSATION AND CLASSIFICATION OF CITY EMPLOYEES IN THE CITY OF JEFFERSONTOWN, KENTUCKY.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has adopted a compensation and classification Ordinance pursuant to KRS 83A.070 (3); and,

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has reviewed said Ordinance and Amendments and recommended amendments thereto.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JEFFERSONTOWN, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION I.** Ordinance No. 1277, Series 2012, as amended by Ordinance 1283, Series 2012, Ordinance 1310, Series 2014, Ordinance 1336, Series 2016, and Ordinance 1339, Series 2016, is hereby amended as follows:

**SECTION II.** There are hereby created the following job classifications and pay grades for all employees within the City of Jeffersontown, Kentucky, to wit:

	<b>Jeffersontown Police Department</b> (This does not include Officers covered by Contract)			
Tele Communicator	Receives, prioritizes, and dispatches multiple incoming calls for service and requests from employees and the public. Operates Department telephone and 911 equipment, CAD system, LINK/NCIC terminal, two-way radio system, and other computer programs. Maintains an awareness of unit activity to ensure officer safety and assists officers with requests for information on individuals, property, and vehicles. Performs other related duties as required.	<b>G12</b>	N	56 Full-time & 4 Part-time
E = Exempt Position (salary) N = Non-Exempt Position (hourly)  <u>NOTE: Whether a position is exempt or non-exempt must be finally determined by the actual nature of the work being performed.</u>				

**SECTION III.** That this Ordinance is intended to modify Ordinance No. 1339, Series 2016 only to the extent set forth above, and otherwise Ordinance No. 1339, Series 2016 remains in full force and effect and is restated herein as if set forth in full.

**SECTION IV.** That this Ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication.

**SECTION V.** Because of the critical nature of this position for the health, safety, and welfare of the general public and the officers of the Jeffersontown Police Department, and the proper functioning of the Department, particularly in emergency situations, it is hereby declared that an emergency exists pursuant to KRS 83A.060(7), and this Ordinance may therefore be enacted upon a single reading.


