**“Scammers and Scoundrels” Series**



Online shopping is convenient and time saving, but it comes with its own brand of hazards. Aside from the obvious danger of having your newly delivered package stolen from your front porch, the online scoundrels have devised a clever plan to scam you with malware. They do this with the “undeliverable” or “rejected” package email. The email contains an attachment or link that, when opened, will infect your computer with malware. The post office, UPS, or FedEx will not contact you by email if a package cannot be delivered. If you receive one of these emails, it is a SCAM. Never use a phone number or address provided in one of these emails. If in doubt, look up the number yourself. As always, the only way to beat the scammers is through awareness and prevention. Stay skeptical!!
