YARD WASTE

General Definition:

1. Leaves, grass vines and weeds
2. Shrubbery and brush accumulated by trimming or storm damage
3. Christmas trees
4. Debris from gardens or flower beds
5. Ground, chipped or shredded herbaceous material

YEAR ROUND YARD WASTE PICK UP IS ON WEDNESDAY FOR ALL RESIDENTS OF THE CITY OF JEFFERSONTOWN



Per our contract with the city, all yard waste must be placed at the curb in 32 gallon or smaller containers. If you have shrubbery or tree trimmings, these items must be tied and bundled in 4 foot lengths or shorter. The weight limit per can or bag is 50 pounds and reasonable lifted by one person.

RECYCLING

WHAT TO RECYCLE

Plastic—Recycle rinsed plastic #1 through #7 with the exception of motor oil and antifreeze containers. Remove all caps and lids. Squeezing containers helps to conserve space in your bin. Please no plastic or paper bags.



Aluminum Beverage Cans/Steel Tin Food Cans—Recycle all beverage cans and steel tin food cans. Please no trash inside of cans and remove all labels. Crushing cans will help conserve space in your bin.

Glass—Recycle all glass bottles and jars. Rinse containers and remove lids and neck rings. Paper labels do not need to be removed. Please no used pesticide or herbicide containers, window glass, light bulbs, mirrors or ceramics.



Newspapers—Recycle newspaper by stacking them in your recycling bin. Please no magazines, advertising supplements, phone books, milk cartons, or other paper products.

If you have more than your bin will hold, place any excess in another container and leave it close to your bin.
