The **Motor Fuel Tax** is project to generate \$540,155.00 (up from last year's \$483,425.00) in revenue from the State of Kentucky for the City of Jeffersontown for Fiscal Year 2010-2021; and as required by statute, these funds are to be used for the purpose of: **MOTOR FUEL TAX: FY 2021-2022**


Road Maintenance,
